ATTORNEY PENTIUK SPEAKS AT MAHC CONFERENCE

Randall Pentiuk, Managing Shareholder of Downriver's law firm Pentiuk, Couvreur & Kobiljak, traveled to Jacksonville, Florida in May to teach two classes at the annual conference of the Midwest Association of Housing Cooperatives ("MAHC"). His first class focused on amending Cooperative bylaws with a focus on changes after the HUD mortgage is paid off and the HUD regulatory agreement is discharged.

Pentiuk also taught a class on legal updates affecting housing cooperatives, an annual class he has taught at MAHC for several years. Court decisions and litigation strategies for Cooperative Boards were highlighted.

As MAHC's Michigan Vice President, Pentiuk also presided over the Michigan caucus of the Michigan membership, and also participated in the annual meeting of the Association. Pentiuk serves on the MAHC Board, in addition to being its State Vice President.
